Notification of Accepted Abstracts

Authors will be informed of the decision of the Scientific Committee at the address given for correspondence by 17 February 2006, and its decision is final. At that time you will be given full details of your presentation.

Please note that all presenters of accepted abstracts will be expected to register for the Congress at the appropriate rate. If the presenter does not register by 5 April 2006 then the abstract will not be printed in the Abstract Book. A registration form is enclosed with this document.
