LETTER OF THE CONGRESS PRESIDENT AND ISMST PRESIDENT

Dear Colleagues,

Thank you for joining us for the 13th Annual ISMST Congress in Chicago, Illinois, USA from Thursday, June 24, 2010 – Saturday, June 26, 2010.
